Order of business

Landscaping

Ralph Pisaturo reported that the landscaper had met with Ken Whitaker, conservation agent for Gloucester. Ken reviewed the proposed changes to the landscaping for fisherman's shack.

- 1) Removal of the wall was approved.
- 2) Less tree cutting was approved.
- 3) Ken stated the plantings and grading on street side needed to be restored. He suggested Bayberry.

Ralph stated he would follow up with Ken to verify landscaper could proceed.
