northerly by said Stevens marsh to the river thence by said river westerly to

they are free of all incumbrances (excepting the burying place road  
to the sea & landing before mentioned) that I have good right to sell  
& convey the same to the said Aaron Wheeler to hold as aforesaid  
and that my heirs executors & administrators shall & will warrant  
& defend the same to the said Aaron Wheeler his heirs & assigns for  
ever against the lawful claims of all persons In Witness whereof I have

one thousand seven hundred & eighty six in the tenth year of the  
American Independance

& northerly on S<sup>d</sup> Bentz till it comes to land of Capt<sup>t</sup> Moody's <sup>Bentz</sup> Northeast  
or by Capt<sup>t</sup> Moody's land till it comes to land lately the property of David  
Woodman deceased to a heap of stones thence bounded easterly by S<sup>d</sup> Woodman's  
it comes to land of Moses Woodman & then southerly by S<sup>d</sup> Woodman's  
land by a wall that formerly enclosed the orchard to the bounds first  
mentioned I have & to hold the S<sup>d</sup> granted & bargained, premises with  
all the privileges & appurtenances free of all incumbrances to him  
the S<sup>d</sup> Sam<sup>o</sup> Longfellow his heirs & assigns forever & I the S<sup>d</sup> William Wood-  
man do covenant & engage that I am lawfully seized in fee of the pre-  
mises that they are free of all incumbrances whatever & that I will war-  
rant & defend the same to the S<sup>d</sup> Sam<sup>o</sup> Longfellow his heirs & assigns  
forever against the lawful claims or demands of all persons In  
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal with my wife -  
Hannah Woodman giving up her right of dower to S<sup>d</sup> premises this  
Twenty-fifth day of March & in the year of our Lord one thousand seven  
hundred Eighty six (underlined before signing)

in consideration of Two hundred pounds lawful money paid me  
by Aaron Wheeler of the same Gloucester fisherman the receipt  
whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant sell and  
convey to the said Aaron Wheeler his heirs & assigns forever  
these several pieces of land laying in Gloucester viz one piece  
containing thirty acres more or less with a dwelling house &  
barn thereon bounded as follows beginning at the northwest corner  
adjoining to the great road leading from Squam parish to the cape  
thence running southerly by land of Peter to land of John Pearce
