I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, sell and convey unto the said John Haraden one right of a piece of land with a Fish-House thereon, in common and undivided with the said Jonathan and Nathaniel Haraden, lying at Daniel's Cove in said Gloucester and called a Flakes Right, formerly owned by Mr. Joseph Lane, and bounded as follows namely, Beginning at the Southwesterly corner of the same about ten feet from the corner of the fish house thence northerly by the road lying westerly of the several Fish-Houses twenty-one feet to the Northwest corner of the Flakes Right owned by A. & C. Langford and C. Langford, thence easterly by said Right one hundred and sixty feet to the wace of Whittemore Sargent's land, thence southerly by said wall twenty-two feet to the Northeast corner of the Flakes Right owned by Whittemore Sargent Jr. thence westerly to the bound first named, together with the privilege belonging to said Right of landing and taking off either side of the Old Wharf.

To Have and to Hold the aforesaid premises with the appurtenances to the said John Haraden his heirs and assigns, to his and their use and behoof forever. And I the said heirs, executors and administrators, do covenant with the said John Haraden, his heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seised in fee of the aforesigned premises, that they are free of all incumbrances,

that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said John Haraden and, that I will and heirs executors, and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said John Haraden heirs and assigns, forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons. *I WITNESS WHEREOF,* the said Jonathan Haraden Jr. and my wife Nancy Haraden who hereby releases her right to dower.
