Gloucester aforesaid unto Joseph Lane, Michael
Whailing, Nathaniel Woodbery, David Lane, Galeb
Woodbery, Winthrop Targent, and David Young, all
of Gloucester aforesaid bearing date January thirty
first seventeen hundred and ninety nine, and
as it is necessary that they should have a Road
to said flake yard and place of landing on the East-
ern shore of said cove, I do hereby Presents, give,
grant, convey Lay out and set of a Road unto the
said Joseph Lane, Michael Whailing, Nathaniel Wood-
bery, David Lane, Galeb Woodbery, Winthrop Targent and
Daniel Young, To them their Heirs and assigns forever,
and all other persons that have any Business now at the
cove, or ever shall hereafter, as a common highway for the
good of all mankind to the latest posterity
Beginning at the western post of the bars on the
Main Road that leads to Gallop's Cove running N. Westerly
one rod wide a little to the Eastward of Jonathan Lane's
Dwelling house, so round said Dwelling house to
the back side and to the S. Western end of Joseph Lane's
fish house, so along the western ends of the fish
houses as they now stand, the length of all the
fish houses, (so to the quay or places of landing
about the old wharf as is fully set forth in their
Deeds)

To Have and to Hold the said
Road to them and theirs and all others as above
mentioned for ever, for a common use and benefit
as above mentioned.
